Technical regulation

The competitions will take place in all categories of Acrobatic Gymnastics:

1. Juniors (up to 19)
2. AGE group (up to 16)

Each athlete takes part in one discipline and category only. AGE group (up to 16) and Junior Competition will be held under the FIG technical Rules for Acrobatics Gymnastics.

Juniors have Balance and Tempo exercises. No final.

AGE group (up to 16) has Balance and Tempo exercises. No final.

Equipment: One main gym floor 'Apollo Diagonal II' blue color, gymnastics mats for warm up.

Schedule:

12. of October – arrival of delegations

13. of October – accreditation, training as per schedule. Orientation meeting

14. of October – Balance and Tempo exercise. AGE group up to 16 and Junior pairs and groups.

Closing ceremony

Awards: One pair or group with the highest number of points from every country will be selected for the Award Ceremony in every event and discipline. 1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded by Diploma and Medal. One pair or group with the highest number of points representing Tallinn's club will be awarded with the diploma and token of Tallinn's Champion.

Judges: Each delegation has to bring at least one judge that has a valid FIG international Brevet 1, 2, 3, 4 category or national category.

Accreditation: 13 October from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. in **Acrobatic School**, Tallinn. Head of Delegation should bring: tariff sheets, national flag, CD with music.

Financial conditions: Each delegation bears the cost of travel, accommodation and meals.

Entry fee is 20 EUR per competitor.
