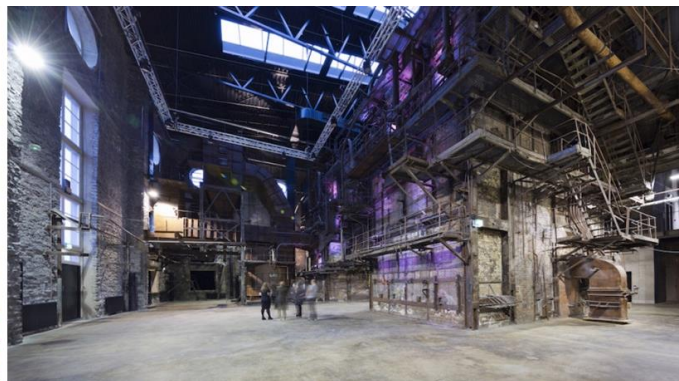
Open Tallinn 2016 will be filmed and staged into a reality show just like in the year 2011. The producer and director of the competition-performance will be **Mart Kangro**. The choreographer lives and works in Tallinn. After dancing for several years at the Estonian National Opera, he dedicated himself solely to his own artistic work, in which he often performs himself. Mart Kangro has collaborated continuously with Thomas Lehmen, Christina Ciupke, also with the composer and soundartist Taavi Kerikmäe and ensemble U:.

Open Tallinn 2016 will be filmed by **Taavi Varm** who is one of the best video artists in Estonia. He also filmed Open Tallinn 2011 competition-performance held in Kalevi Spordihall which was a part of the Cultural Capital of Europe 2011 programme. Most recently Taavi Varm made the video design for the Estonian Independence Day Reception.

Competition Venue

Kultuurikatel (Creative Hub) in Tallinn, Estonia

Tallinn Creative Hub is located in the former building of Tallinn City Central Power Station, which began operating in 1913. Today it is a temple of culture on the border between Kalamaja and the city centre holding concerts, theatre performances, conferences, learning clubs, workshops, exhibitions and festivals.



Provisional Schedule

16th - 17th of November – Arrival of delegations. Accreditation. Training as per schedule.
Orientation meeting.
18th of November – Competition Day 1
19th of November – Competition Day 2 – Youth and AGE group FINAL. Closing Ceremony.

Please note: Schedule is provisional and may be adjusted after entries are received.

Technical regulation

The competitions will take place in all categories of Acrobatic Gymnastics:

1. **Youth (11 - 16)**
2. **AGE group (11 - 16)**

Each athlete takes part in one discipline and category.

AGE group competitions will be held under the FIG technical rules for Acrobatic Gymnastics.

Youth (11 - 16)

1 Combined exercise (*Difficulty is calculated just like in FIG 11-16 Age Group*).

2min 30sec of maximum duration.

Pairs: Choose 2 balance elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables.

Groups: Choose 1 pyramid from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional pyramid from FIG tables (**only 2 static holds of 3" are required in the routine**) and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables; the optional pyramid may be selected from one of the same categories used in the compulsory elements.

Individuals: 2 cat. 1 + 2 cat. 2 individual elements must be executed (*NO SALTO REQUIRED*).

Youth has Combined exercises and Final.

AGE group (11 - 16) has Balance and Tempo exercises and Final.

Judges

Each delegation has to bring at least one judge that has a valid FIG international Brevet 1, 2, 3, 4 category or national category.

150€ penalty fee if no judge is presented.

Equipment

One main gym floor “Apollo Diagonal II” blue color, gymnastics mats for warm up.

Accreditation

17th of November – Head of Delegation should bring: competitor’s passports, tariff sheets, national flag, CD with music.

Financial conditions

- The delegations are responsible for covering travel expenses, accommodation, meals and entry fee.
- The entry fee is not refundable.

30 EUR per competitor.
